





RCMBA HISTORY

Redwood Coast Mountain Bike Association (RCMBA) began as Bigfoot Bike Club in the early 1990s as a recreational club for mountain bikers to ride together. It subsequently evolved into a trail advocacy and event coordinating organization, working with the City of Arcata, Bureau of Land Management, USFS; and developing races including the Bigfoot Bike Race, 12 Hours of Humboldt, Tish Tang Tangle and others. One of its founding members, Tim Daniels, is a current RCMBA Board member and continues the legacy of trail advocacy and building a healthy local biking community.

STRATEGIC PLANNING PROCESS

The RCMBA Board gathered for a planning retreat in July 2022. All 12 members were present and worked through a standardized strategic planning process facilitated by Board Member Sean Robertson, who has organizational experience in strategic plan development. The Board met over three days to develop a mission and vision statement, conduct a SWOT (strength, weakness, opportunity, threat) analysis, and identify short (1 year) and long- (1-5 years) term goals. These goals were consolidated into four key areas, and further separated into short and long-term time periods. Following the retreat, the author captured the plan notes and formatted them into this document including identification of assignees using the existing Board Operations Plan Committees, and expected timelines for accomplishment of goals. Next steps in the plan include dissemination to all members followed by a public meeting to solicit input, and formal adoption by the Board at the winter public meeting.
